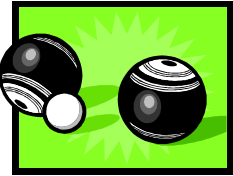


BOCCE BALL

SWIMMING LESSONS - DATES & TIMES
JULY 5 - JULY 15



Introduction to water skills: Promotes water safety knowledge and practices aquatic adjustment, swimming readiness skills -

10 a.m., 5 p.m. & 6 p.m.

Level II: Fundamental Aquatic Skills: To build on the fundamentals of aquatic locomotion, safety, rescue skills - **10 a.m. & 11 a.m.**

Level III: Stroke Development: Additional guided practice on strokes, safe diving, retrieving objects, gliding, rescue breathing -

10 a.m. & 11 a.m.

Level IV: Stroke Development: To develop confidence and competency in building endurance with strokes, diving, kicks, breathing techniques - **10 a.m. & 11 a.m.**

Level V: Stroke Refinement: Coordinate and refine the key strokes presented thus far and introduce butterfly, open turns, feet-first surface dive, spring board diving - **10 a.m.**

Level VI: Personal Water Safety: Polish strokes, swim with efficiency, power smoothness, great distance, introduce pike dive, tuck dive, additional turns - **11 a.m.**

Guard Start: Individual who have completed all six levels and are interested in learning the basic skills to becoming a lifeguard - **(Must have completed Level VI)**

Adaptive Aquatics: 6-7 p.m.

EACH class has a \$5.00 charge, (exception: Adaptive Aquatics)

SWIM TEAM - Registration is open for boys & girls who are able to swim across the pool through age 18. Practices are held Monday - Friday, 12:00 noon - 1:00 p.m., beginning June 6 - the middle of July.

"12 DANCING PRINCESSES"

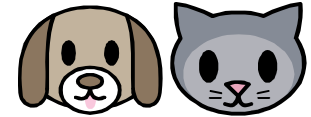
